LORD TRANSFORM ME CAMPAIGN January 26th – February 9th, 2019.

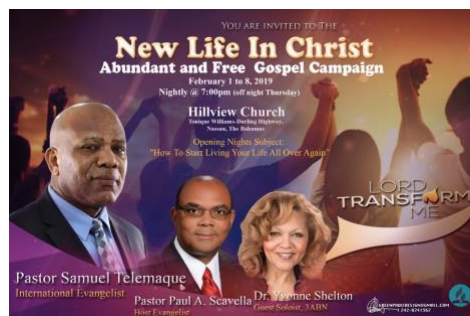

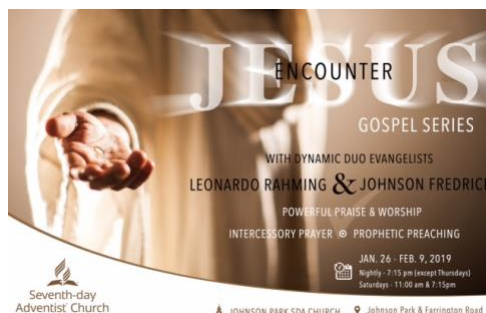

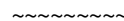

The Breath of Life church will hold a blood drive on January 26, 2019 from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. All are invited to come, donate and save a life.

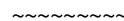
